An 18-core optical fiber cable is a versatile fiber optic cable with 18 individual fibers, suitable for indoor and outdoor telecommunications, FTTX networks, and high-performance data transmission.

An 18-core optical fiber cable contains 18 individual optical fibers, which can be arranged in loose tubes or other configurations. These cables are often all-dielectric self-supporting (ADSS), meaning they do not require metallic support and can be installed aerially between poles or buildings without additional support structures . The cable typically includes:

- Strength members such as aramid yarns for tensile strength
- Outer jackets made of polyethylene (PE) or low-smoke zero-halogen (LSZH) materials for environmental protection
- Loose tube design to protect fibers from mechanical stress and allow for expansion and contraction

- Direct burial or duct installations in industrial or enterprise environments...
