Importing network security equipment involves strict customs and regulatory requirements. An Importer of Record (IOR) is legally responsible for ensuring that all imported goods comply with local laws, including documentation, duties, taxes, and technical compliance for networking equipment. Certain equipment, especially from vendors like Huawei, ZTE, Hikvision, Dahua, or Kaspersky, may be restricted or require special approval due to national security concerns in the United States. Routers and other network devices produced abroad may also need conditional approval from relevant authorities.

The average import price for network equipment is approximately \$121.64 per unit, though this varies by type, capacity, and supplier. The global network security market is projected to grow significantly, reaching USD 119.70 billion by 2030, driven by cyber threats, cloud adoption, and demand for next-generation firewalls and hybrid mesh solutions.
