Abnormal noise from a busbar cable tray is often caused by vibrations, loose connections, or resonance effects, and should be investigated promptly to prevent equipment damage or safety hazards.

Common Causes of Noise

- **Vibration of Busbars and Steel Supports** Busbars can vibrate due to alternating current (AC) electromagnetic forces, especially if the busbar supports or steel plates are inadequately fixed. Long cantilevered sections or insufficiently thick panels may resonate with the AC frequency (50Hz $\pm$ 20%) or its multiples, producing loud buzzing or impact sounds .
- **Loose Connections or Bolts** Loose busbar joints, bolts, or insulators can amplify vibrations and generate noise. High contact resistance at joints can also cause localized heating, further increasing vibration and sound .
- **Eddy Currents and Electromagnetic Forces** Conductive materials near the busbar can develop eddy currents, causing heat, vibration, and noise. Electromagnetic forces acting on steel plates or metallic enclosures can induce oscillations if the structure is not rigid .
- **Cable Tray Resonance Noise** may propagate through cable trays if they are not properly insulated or supported. Sound insulation and vibration damping can reduce the transmission of noise along the tray .
