Not all electrical wires are routed through an overhead distribution box; it primarily manages and distributes incoming power to multiple circuits safely and efficiently.

Function of a Distribution Box

A distribution box, also known as a service panel or breaker box, is the central point where incoming electrical power is divided into individual circuits for a building or facility. It ensures that each circuit is protected by fuses or circuit breakers, provides grounding, and allows for organized cable management . While it handles the majority of internal wiring for a building, wires from the utility's overhead distribution system enter the box through a service drop or conduit, but not every wire in the network passes through it .

Overhead Distribution System

In an overhead distribution system, medium- or low-voltage power is carried along poles and crossarms to service drops that connect to customer premises . The system includes conductors, transformers, cutouts, reclosers, and surge arresters. The service drop is the final connection from the utility pole to the building, where wires enter through a weatherhead and then pass to the distribution box . The distribution box then steps down voltage if necessary, isolates circuits, and distributes power to branch circuits within the building
