

Analysis of Uganda Optical Cable Testing Routes



Article Overview

Uganda's optical cable network is expanding through new terrestrial routes and advanced testing methods, ensuring reliable connectivity from coastal submarine cables to inland regions.

Terrestrial and Subsea Routes

Uganda, being landlocked, relies heavily on submarine cables landing in Mombasa and Dar es Salaam. To mitigate disruptions from aging undersea cables, telecom operators have developed new terrestrial routes. MTN Uganda completed a 1,000-kilometre terrestrial fiber network linking Kampala to Malaba, Kenya, with a 260-kilometre spur along the Malaba-Kampala railway line, connecting to subsea cable landing stations in Mombasa. This route enhances reliability and capacity, providing an alternative to older submarine cables and reducing the risk of Internet outages in the hinterland. Airtel Uganda is also exploring satellite connectivity via Starlink to complement terrestrial fiber networks.

Optical Fiber Testing with OTDR

Optical Time-Domain Reflectometers (OTDRs) are central to testing Uganda's fiber routes. OTDRs send high-power light pulses through the fiber and measure backscattered signals to detect faults, breaks, or high-loss connections. Modern OTDRs in Uganda can test fibers up to 200 km, with dynamic ranges of 35–45 dB and dead zones of 0.8–1.5 meters for event detection. This technology allows engineers...
