Each line from an optical splitter typically connects to a separate ONT, and each ONT is assigned its own unique IP address, even though they share the same OLT port.

How Optical Splitters Work

An optical splitter is a passive device that divides a single optical signal from the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) into multiple outputs for Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at subscribers' homes. For example, a 1×32 splitter can distribute one input fiber to 32 output fibers, allowing multiple users to share the same feeder fiber without requiring a dedicated fiber for each subscriber. The splitter itself does not assign IP addresses; it only distributes the optical signal.

IP Address Assignment in PON

In a Passive Optical Network (PON), the OLT manages the network and communicates with each ONT individually. Each ONT connected to the splitter is treated as a separate endpoint and is assigned a unique IP address by the service provider's DHCP server or through static configuration. This ensures that even though multiple ONTs share the same physical OLT port via the splitter, each subscriber has a distinct network identity.
