

Are there cable trays above the low-voltage electrical shaft How are they installed



Article Overview

Cable trays are commonly installed above low-voltage electrical shafts, with high-voltage or power trays positioned on top and low-voltage or instrumentation trays below to minimize interference.

Typical Placement

In industrial and commercial installations, high-voltage or power cable trays are usually installed above low-voltage or control cable trays. This layered arrangement reduces electromagnetic interference (EMI) from power cables affecting sensitive low-voltage instrumentation or communication lines . A minimum vertical separation of 300 mm (12 inches) is recommended between power and control trays, and metal dividers can be used if space is limited . Low-voltage cables, such as data, signaling, or control circuits, are therefore typically routed in trays below the main electrical shaft.

Installation Practices

Support and Mounting: Cable trays are supported by brackets, hangers, or threaded rods attached to walls, ceilings, or structural beams. Supports are spaced according to tray type and load, often every 1.5 to 3 meters for ladder or ventilated trays . **Tray Types:...**
