

Brunei Level 3 Distribution Box Parameters



Article Overview

A Level 3 distribution box in Brunei is the final junction box for individual electrical appliances, designed for movable or fixed installation with full leakage protection and compliance with construction electricity standards.

Overview

In Brunei, Level 3 distribution boxes are part of a three-level protection system for construction and standard electrical installations. They serve as the final junction point for each electrical appliance, ensuring safety and proper distribution of electricity from the main and secondary distribution boxes. These boxes are typically installed under the secondary distribution box and switch box, forming a hierarchical system of protection.

Key Parameters and Features

- **Protection and Safety:** Level 3 boxes include the last stage of leakage protection, connecting appliances through a dedicated leakage protection switch. This ensures that each device is individually protected, following the principle of "one machine, one switch, one leakage, one box, one lock".
- **Construction:** Boxes are often fabricated from 2 mm galvanized steel sheets with reinforced structures, slanted roofs for water runoff, and IP-55 degree of protection against dust and water ingress.
- **Busbar and Wiring:** Busbars are made of copper flat bars (e.g., 25x4 mm) with he...
