Recommended Burial Depths

The depth at which fiber optic cables are buried depends on location, environmental conditions, and potential hazards. Common guidelines include:

- Residential or commercial areas: 24 to 36 inches (60-90 cm) deep to protect against accidental digging and surface activities .
- Roadways or driveways: 36 to 48 inches (90-120 cm) deep, often within a conduit for added protection .
- Agricultural or rural land: At least 36 inches (90 cm) to prevent damage from plowing or heavy equipment .
- Rocky or difficult terrain: Depth may be reduced if the cable is armored or placed in a protective conduit .

- Armored construction: Provides crush and rodent protection, often using corrugated steel tape or interlocking armor .
