

Burn the telecommunications fiber optic cable

Fiber optic cables can potentially cause fires under specific conditions, and physical damage can disrupt critical telecommunications services.

Fire Risk from Fiber Optics

While fiber optic cables themselves do not carry electricity, high-power optical signals can generate enough localized heat to ignite surrounding materials if the cable is cut or damaged while active. For example, a CATV operator experienced a fire when a 144-fiber cable carrying 20 dBm of EDFA-amplified optical power was cut at a service loop, even though the absolute power per fiber was only 100 mW. The confinement of light in a tiny core (8–10 μm) concentrates energy, which can lead to ignition under certain conditions . Most commercial fiber optic cables are flame-retardant and comply with safety standards such as the National Electric Code (NEC) and are tested by recognized laboratories (NRTL) to minimize fire hazards . However, improper handling or exposure to extreme heat can still pose risks.

Mechanical and Physical Damage

Fiber optic cables are extremely delicate, with cores thinner than a human hair. Mechanical stress—such as bending beyond the minimum radius, crushing, or cutting—can break the glass core, causing signal loss, data errors, or complete service outages. Even minor nicks can reduce transmission distance by half in single-mode fibers, potentially affecting entire neighborhoods or critical services like hospi...
