

Cable Numbering Rules for Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Cable numbering in distribution boxes follows standardized rules to ensure uniqueness, traceability, and clear identification of power and control circuits.

Core Principles

Cable numbering must adhere to four key principles: uniqueness, readability, continuity, and correspondence. Each cable should have a unique identifier within the distribution box or system, be legible with appropriate font and color contrast, follow a sequential order within the same circuit, and be marked at both ends to indicate its connection points .

Numbering Structure

- Power (Main) Circuits:
 - Numbering typically combines the component number, phase sequence, and serial number.
 - Parallel power cables are treated as a single cable number with suffixes like /1, /2 for multiple runs.
 - Multiple single-core cables are numbered sequentially with a dash, e.g., /L1-1, /L2-1, /L3-1 .
- Control (Secondary) Circuits:
 - Numbering starts with a distinct series, often using a different leading digit (e.g., 3001 for control cables if 1001 is used for power)...
