

Cable tray connection with mechanical equipment



Article Overview

Cable trays should be mechanically and electrically bonded to equipment using proper grounding, bonding clamps, and secure supports to ensure safety and compliance.

Mechanical Connection

When connecting a cable tray to mechanical equipment, the tray must be physically supported and anchored to prevent movement or stress on cables. Typical methods include:

- Direct attachment to equipment enclosures using brackets, threaded rods, or trapeze supports, ensuring the tray is level and stable .
- Use of factory fittings or splices to extend or transition trays to equipment while maintaining structural integrity .
- Material considerations: Aluminum trays should avoid direct contact with bare copper conductors to prevent electrolytic corrosion; insulated conductors or tin/zinc-plated connectors are recommended .
