Metal partitions in cable trays provide physical separation of cables, enhancing safety, reducing electromagnetic interference, and improving system organization.

### Purpose of Metal Partitions

Metal partitions are installed within cable trays to segregate different types of cables, such as power and data lines, ensuring compliance with safety codes like the NEC and minimizing electromagnetic interference (EMI) that can affect sensitive signals . They also simplify maintenance, troubleshooting, and future upgrades by keeping cables organized and clearly separated .

### Materials and Construction

Metal partitions are typically made from pre-galvanized steel, hot-dip galvanized steel, stainless steel, or powder-coated aluminum . These materials offer corrosion resistance, durability, and long service life, making them suitable for industrial, commercial, and outdoor environments. Some partitions are perforated to allow airflow and heat dissipation, while others are solid for maximum separation .
