If you're installing a network switch in a 4U rack, prioritize depth compatibility first — most standard 4U wall-mount or vertical racks offer only 12–17 inches of usable depth, while many enterprise switches exceed 20 inches. For typical home labs, UniFi deployments, or small office edge networks. Wall-mount cabinet secures and organizes 4U of 19-inch rack equipment in network wiring closets and other locations with limited floor space. Houses equipment up to 20 inches deep, but extends just 8 inches from wall.
