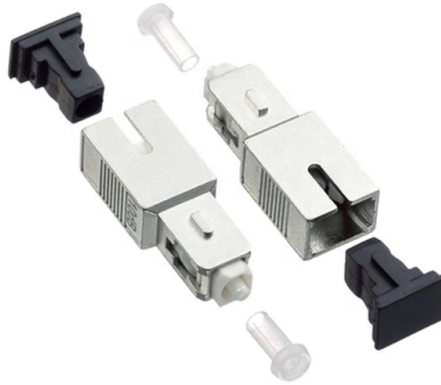


Can fiber optic cables be tied to towers
