

Can low-voltage cables share the same cable tray



Article Overview

Low-voltage cables can be run in the same cable tray with other low-voltage cables, but separation from power cables is required to prevent interference and ensure safety.

NEC and Standards Guidance

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 300.3(C)(1) and Article 392, low-voltage cables (such as control, communication, or instrumentation cables) should not be mixed with power cables in the same tray unless proper separation or shielding is provided . Cables rated 600 volts or less can generally share a tray if they meet fill and support requirements, but higher-voltage cables require either Type MC construction or a solid barrier to separate them from lower-voltage cables .

Risks of Mixing Cables

Running low-voltage cables alongside power cables without separation can cause:

- Electromagnetic interference (EMI), which can disrupt sensitive signals in communication or control circuits .
- Voltage induction, where high-voltage lines induce unwanted voltages in nearby low-voltage circuits .
- Fire hazards due to overheating if tray fill limits are exceeded or cables are improperly grouped
