Conduit Use and Requirements

Low-voltage wiring (typically under 50 volts) includes data, security, HVAC control, and audiovisual cables. While these systems are safer than high-voltage circuits, they still require protection against physical damage, moisture, and interference. Embedding conduits provides mechanical protection, organizes cables, and facilitates future upgrades. According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) and most local building codes, low-voltage cables must be enclosed in conduit when:

- Installed in exposed or high-traffic areas, attics, basements, or garages .
- Buried underground or passing through concrete or masonry .
- Sharing pathways with high-voltage circuits to prevent interference .
- Installed in commercial or industrial facilities requiring durability and fire-rated protection . In residential, dry, and easily accessible areas, conduit is often optional if the cable is rated for in-wall use (CL2, CL3, CM, or CMR), but it remains recommended for organization and future-proofing
