

Can the insulation be stripped from cable trays



Article Overview

Stripping the insulation of a cable inside a cable tray is generally not recommended due to safety and integrity risks.

Safety and Integrity Concerns

Stripping cable insulation exposes the conductive core, which can lead to short circuits, electrical shocks, or fire hazards if the cable is live or comes into contact with other conductors . Cable trays are designed to support and protect cables, not to serve as a workspace for stripping insulation. Performing stripping inside a tray increases the risk of damaging adjacent cables or the tray itself, especially if sharp tools are used .

Recommended Practices

- Remove the cable from the tray: It is safer to strip insulation on a workbench or a controlled area where the cable can be securely held .
- Use proper tools: Wire strippers or stripping pliers should be used to avoid nicking or cutting the conductor, which can compromise electrical performance .
- Inspect after stripping: Always check that the conductor is intact and that no insulation fragments remain, which could cause short circuits .
- Avoid excessive force: Applying too much pressure can stretch or break the wire, especially in confined spaces like a cable tray .
