Cold-galvanized cable trays can be used in indoor or non-corrosive environments, but they are generally less protective than hot-dip galvanized trays and require careful consideration of environmental conditions.

What Cold-Galvanized Means

Cold galvanization refers to a zinc-rich coating applied to steel at low temperatures, often as a paint or electroplated layer, to protect areas exposed after cutting or welding of pre-galvanized steel . Unlike hot-dip galvanization (HDG), which immerses steel in molten zinc, cold galvanization provides a thinner zinc layer and primarily protects against corrosion through sacrificial action, but its durability is lower than HDG .

Suitable Applications

Cold-galvanized cable trays are generally suitable for:

- Indoor environments with controlled humidity and minimal corrosive agents .
- Areas where aesthetic appearance is important and heavy corrosion protection is not critical .
- Situations where pre-galvanized steel has been cut or welded, and the exposed areas need additional zinc protection . They are not recommended for highly corrosive environments**, such as areas with high chlorine, salt, or chemical exposure, where hot-dip galvanized or stainless steel trays are preferred
