The fiber termination box is an interface between the fiber cable from the line side and the pigtails to be passed to the fiber distribution frame. A fiber pigtail is a specific hardware connection used for cable termination. Thus, a fiber termination box is used to terminate the optical fiber. A combination of fiber enclosure and splice tray is the fiber splice enclosure. It functions as a junction between the incoming fiber cable and the outgoing customer-side fiber cable, where one fiber can be spliced, patched. A Fiber Termination Box, also known as an optical termination box (OTB), is a compact, specialized enclosure designed for the organization, termination, splicing, and protection of fiber optic cables.
