

Connection method of single-mode fiber optic transceiver a and b ends



Overview

With single-fiber LC connectors and duplex jumpers, this is handled by the jumper's two-fiber labeling -- the A leg goes to one transceiver port, the B leg goes to the other, and a built-in crossover ensures TX-to-RX. Fiber optics relies on a bidirectional transmission where the transmitter port on one end connects to the receiver port on the other end. Method B is the default for new builds: Type. To solve this issue, the TIA-568 standard defines three polarity implementation methods (Method A, B, and C), which are achieved by using specifically mapped MTP®/MPO cable types (Type A, B, and C). This article explains what MTP®/MPO polarity is, what MTP®/MPO Type A/B/C cables stand for, and how. Fiber polarity is the direction that light signals travel from one end of a fiber optic cable (link) to the other.
