

# Connections between fiber optic trays



## Article Overview

The recommended way to connect two fiber optic trays is by using patch cords and adapters to link the terminated fibers, ensuring a clean, flexible, and low-loss connection.

### Step 1: Understand the Connection Method

Fiber optic trays are designed to organize and protect fibers, not to serve as permanent splice points for direct fusion splicing between trays. The safest and most standardized approach is to use fiber patch cords and adapters to bridge the two trays, maintaining network performance and allowing easy maintenance or reconfiguration .

### Step 2: Prepare the Fibers

- Inspect and clean connectors using lint-free wipes and fiber cleaning solution to remove dust or oils. Never touch the fiber tip with bare hands .
- Identify connector types (e.g., SC/APC, SC/UPC, LC/UPC, MPO) to ensure compatibility. Mismatched connectors can cause reflection and signal loss .

### Step 3: Install Adapters in the Trays

- Mount fiber adapters (couplers) securely in each tray. These adapters bridge the connectors from the patch cords to the tray fibers.
- If connecting different connector types, use hybrid adapters to match them (e.g., SC to LC), ....
