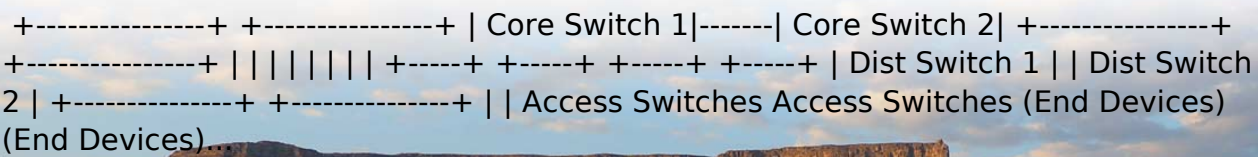
Core switches form the high-speed backbone of a network, interconnecting distribution switches and ensuring redundancy and high throughput.

Core Switch Topology Overview

In a hierarchical network, core switches sit at the top layer, aggregating traffic from multiple distribution switches and forwarding it across the network . A typical connection diagram includes:

- Multiple Core Switches: At least two core switches are deployed for redundancy and load balancing.
- Distribution Switch Connections: Each distribution switch connects to both core switches to prevent a single point of failure.
- Redundant Links: Links between core switches and distribution switches often use link aggregation (LACP) to increase bandwidth and reliability.
- Optional Core-to-Core Links: Core switches may be interconnected directly to allow fast failover and inter-core routing.
