

# Core Switch Output Port Speed

Core switch output ports typically support speeds ranging from 1G to 400G, depending on the switch model and port type.

### Typical Port Speeds and Types

Modern core switches, such as the Cisco Catalyst 9500 and 9600 series, support a wide range of port speeds to accommodate high-throughput enterprise and data center networks. Common port types and speeds include:

- SFP/SFP+ ports: 1G or 10G, often used for uplinks or aggregation connections .
- SFP28 ports: 25G, suitable for high-density data center uplinks .
- QSFP+ ports: 40G, typically used in spine-leaf or core aggregation fabrics .
- QSFP28 ports: 100G, for high-capacity core or data center interconnects .
- QSFP-DD and OSFP ports: 200G to 400G, found on next-generation core switches for ultra-high-speed backbone links .

For example, the Cisco Catalyst 9500X supports nonblocking 50G SFP-56 and 400G QSFP-DD ports, while the Catalyst 9600 series provides 1G-25G SFP and 40G-100G QSFP ports, with ASICs capable of multi-terabit switching capacity .

### Factors Affecting Output Port Speed

- Switch ASIC and PHY design: Some SFP+ ports can downspeed to 1G if the ASIC supports dual-rate SerDes, while others cannot .
- Port configuration: Logical modes (access, trunk, routed) do not change physical speed but affect traffic handling ....
