Equipment malfunctions, including faulty or poorly maintained power distribution units (PDUs), cooling systems, or UPS components, can lead to pressure build-ups or thermal runaway, increasing the risk of explosions . Environmental factors like dust accumulation, high humidity, or inadequate ventilation can exacerbate these hazards .
