

Dedicated fiber optic channel on the power plant side



Article Overview

A dedicated fiber optic channel at a power plant provides high-speed, reliable communication for protection, control, and monitoring systems, often with nanosecond-level time synchronization.

Purpose and Functionality

Dedicated fiber optic channels are used in power plants to ensure secure, high-bandwidth communication between critical equipment such as protection relays, control systems, and remote load dispatch centers. These channels are particularly important for transmitting real-time analog measurements (voltages and currents) and digital control signals with minimal latency and high reliability . They support time synchronization with precision better than 25 nanoseconds, which is essential for accurate protection and fault detection .

Bandwidth and Transmission

A dedicated fiber channel can handle substantial data loads. For example, continuously transmitting six analog measurements sampled at one million times per second requires around 145 Mbps, which is typically transported over a 1 Gbps Ethernet channel using SFP transceivers. These transceivers allow flexibility in matching the required transmission distance and wavelength .
