Article Overview

In typical FTTH networks, the distance from an optical splitter to a home usually ranges from a few hundred meters up to about 1 kilometer, depending on network architecture and deployment density.

Overview of Splitter Placement

In a Passive Optical Network (PON), optical splitters divide a single fiber from the central office (OLT) to serve multiple homes. Splitters can be placed in two main configurations:

- Centralized splitters: Located near the central office or in a fiber distribution hub (FDH), with fibers running directly to each home. This "home run" configuration allows distances up to approximately 1 kilometer (3,000–4,000 feet) from the splitter to the home, though longer distances are possible with proper signal management .
- Distributed splitters: Placed closer to the subscriber, often in street-side closures or pedestals. This reduces the fiber length from the splitter to the home, typically a few hundred meters, and can improve signal strength and reduce fiber usage .

Factors Affecting Distance

- Network Architecture: Centralized home run designs require longer fibers from the splitter to each home, while distributed splitting reduces this distance.
- Subscriber Density: In dense urban areas, splitters may be closer to homes to minimize fiber length and simplify maintenance. In suburban or rural areas, splitter...
