

Do cable trays need internal connecting plates



Article Overview

Cable trays do not always require internal connecting plates, but splice plates or similar mechanical connectors are commonly used to secure tray sections and ensure structural integrity.

Purpose of Internal Connecting Plates

Internal connecting plates, often called splice plates, are flat metal plates with pre-drilled holes used to join two cable tray sections in a straight line or at angles. They provide mechanical strength, maintain alignment, and allow for secure bolted connections between tray sections, which is especially important for long runs or heavy cable loads. These plates also allow for disassembly or modification of the tray system if needed.

Installation Considerations

- **Mechanical Security:** Splice plates are bolted to the ends of tray sections to create a strong, reliable connection. They are standard for most tray types and are widely available.
- **Alternative Systems:** Some manufacturers offer quick-connect systems that snap, slide, or twist together, reducing the need for traditional splice plates. These are faster to install but may be brand-specific and cost more upfront.
- **Angles and Junctions:** L, T, or cross-shaped plates are used at corners or splits to maintain proper cable routing and structural stability
