

# Do fire protection and low-voltage electrical systems use the same cable tray



## Article Overview

Fire alarm (PLFA) circuits and low-voltage communication or data cables can share the same cable tray under specific conditions, but dedicated pathways or physical separation are strongly recommended for safety and reliability.

### Regulatory Perspective

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) 760.139 (A), power-limited fire alarm (PLFA) circuits are permitted to share a cable tray, raceway, or enclosure with communications circuits or Class 3 circuits, provided the insulation and installation meet code requirements (760.139 B and D) . This allowance applies because both systems are low-voltage, reducing the risk of dangerous voltage interactions. However, circuits such as audio systems using Class 2 or Class 3 wiring may not be included under this provision unless specifically allowed .

### Best Practices and Safety Considerations

Even though code permits shared trays, industry best practices recommend physical separation to protect the fire alarm system from mechanical damage, electromagnetic interference (EMI), and accidental faults during installation or maintenance . Key considerations include:...
