

Do not touch the switch in the distribution box

Touching the switch or any live component in a distribution box can be extremely dangerous and should only be done by qualified personnel.

Why You Should Avoid Touching the Switch

A distribution box, also known as a breaker box or electrical panel, manages the flow of electricity into your home or facility and contains high-voltage components such as the main breaker, bus bars, and live wires. Contact with these parts can result in severe electric shock, burns, or even fire because they carry electricity directly from the utility supply . Even when the power appears off, residual electricity may still be present, posing a hidden risk .

Safe Operation Guidelines

- Keep hands dry and avoid touching the switch with wet hands. Operate switches laterally with one hand while maintaining a safe distance from the panel .
- Do not place objects or temporary equipment inside the distribution box, and ensure the area is clean and free of obstacles .
- Follow proper shutdown procedures: turn off the external power supply first, then the main switch. When powering on, reverse the order .
- Never attempt repairs or adjustments unless you are a qualified electrician. Only trained personnel should handle electrical isolation, testing, or maintenance

Use one hand to operate the switch laterally, keep a certain distance between the face and the electric box, and do not operate the
