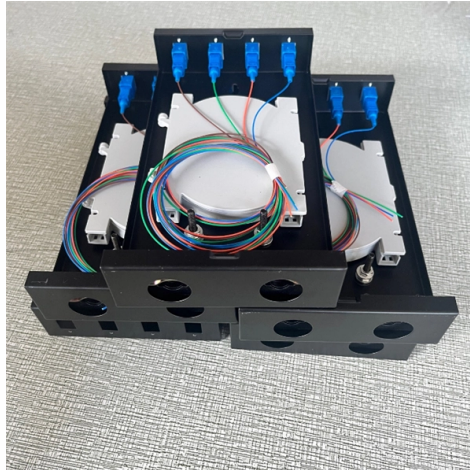


Does fiber optic cable fall under cable engineering
