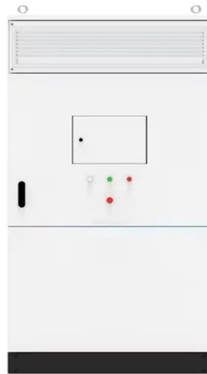


Does fiber optic cable transmit signals

How Fiber Optic Cables Work

Fiber optic cables transmit information using pulses of light, which represent digital data (0s and 1s) instead of electrical signals used in copper wires . The light is generated by lasers or LEDs and travels through the core of the fiber, which is made of ultrapure glass or plastic . Surrounding the core is the cladding, a layer with a slightly lower refractive index that reflects light back into the core, enabling total internal reflection and preventing signal loss . A protective coating and outer jacket shield the fiber from physical and environmental damage .

Signal Transmission Process

- **Encoding Data:** Information such as voice, video, or internet data is converted into light signals through modulation techniques, which can vary the light's intensity or pulse timing .
- **Propagation:** Light pulses travel through the fiber core, bouncing off the cladding to maintain signal integrity over long distances .
- **Reception:** At the receiving end, optical transceivers convert the light pulses back into electrical signals for processing by computers or communication devices .

- **High Bandwidth:** Fiber optics can carry vastly more data than copper wires
