Core Switch in Network Topology

A core switch sits at the backbone of a hierarchical network, connecting multiple distribution switches and providing high-speed, low-latency routing across the network . It acts as the central hub, aggregating traffic from lower layers and ensuring efficient data flow between servers, VLANs, and end-user devices . In diagrams, the core switch is typically placed at the top of the hierarchy, with distribution switches below it and access switches at the edge layer .

Physical vs Logical Topology

- Physical topology shows the actual hardware connections, such as uplinks from the core switch to distribution switches and edge devices.
- Logical topology illustrates how traffic flows, VLAN segmentation, and routing paths, which may differ from the physical layout . For example, in a typical diagram, the core switch may host Layer 3 VLANs and act as a DHCP server, while edge switches maintain Layer 2 VLANs. Traffic between VLANs is routed through the core switch, and redundant links or stacked switches can be included to ensure fault tolerance
