Optical ports, such as SFP (1G), SFP+ (10G), SFP28 (25G), and QSFP/QSFP+ (40G/100G), are commonly used for uplinks and inter-switch connections in data centers and enterprise networks . For example, a typical L3 managed core switch may have 24 RJ45 ports for standard Ethernet connections and 4 SFP+ fiber ports for 1/10G uplinks, enabling high-bandwidth aggregation and long-distance connectivity . These optical ports require compatible transceivers and fiber cables, and they can be used to connect to other core or distribution switches, ensuring low-latency, high-throughput communication . In summary, optical ports are a standard feature on core switches, providing the flexibility to support high-speed fiber links, extend network reach, and maintain the performance and reliability expected from the network backbone .
