Yes, a distribution box must be grounded to ensure safety, prevent electrical shock, and comply with electrical codes.

Why Grounding is Necessary

Grounding a distribution box is essential for several reasons:

- Safety against electrical faults: If a live wire accidentally contacts the metal enclosure, grounding provides a low-resistance path for fault current, preventing the box from becoming energized and reducing the risk of electric shock to anyone touching it .
- Static discharge protection: Metal doors and panels can accumulate static electricity, which can be discharged safely if properly grounded .
- Code compliance: NEC standards, such as 250.148 and 314.28, require metallic junction boxes and cabinet doors to be bonded to ground using designated grounding screws or clips .

How to Properly Ground a Distribution Box

- Connect to the grounding system: The distribution box should be connected to the building's main grounding system or factory ground using a dedicated grounding conductor .
- Use appropriate conductors: In the US, a 10 AWG copper wire is typically used, while other markets may require a 6 mm² wire
