They are ideal for 40G, 100G, and 400G network links, enabling rapid deployment in data centers and backbone applications.

Connector Configurations

- Four 12-fiber MPO connectors: Suitable for 40G links, transporting individual 40G signals but limited for higher-speed aggregation.
- Two 24-fiber MPO connectors: Can carry up to three 40G signals or a single 100G signal, providing an upgrade-friendly path from 10G to 100G and beyond.
- Single 48-fiber MPO connector: Consolidates all fibers into one high-density connector, simplifying inspection, maintenance, and cable management.
