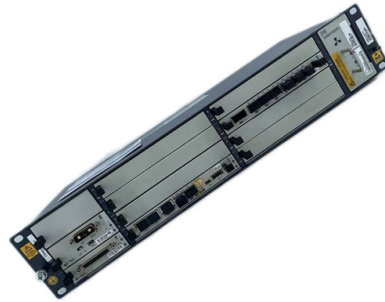


Does the optical splitter output the same signal

Signals from the same optical splitter are generally similar but not perfectly identical due to split ratio, insertion loss, and uniformity variations.

Signal Distribution in Optical Splitters

An optical splitter divides a single input signal into multiple output signals. The split ratio determines how the optical power is distributed among the outputs. For example, a 1:4 splitter divides the input signal into four outputs, ideally giving each output one-fourth of the total power. However, the actual power at each output can vary slightly due to manufacturing tolerances and the type of splitter used.

Factors Affecting Signal Equality

- Insertion Loss: Every splitter introduces some signal loss, measured in decibels (dB). Higher split ratios (e.g., 1:32 or 1:64) result in greater insertion loss, reducing the signal strength at each output.
- Uniformity: This refers to how evenly the input power is distributed across all output ports. PLC splitters provide highly uniform outputs, while FBT splitters may have slight variations, especially at higher split ratios.
- Splitter Type:
 - FBT (Fused Biconical Taper) Splitters: Effective for low split ratios (1:2, 1:4) but may produce uneven output signals.
 - PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) Splitters: Offer consistent and reliable output across all ports, even for high split ratios (1:32, 1:64),
