Key Design and Material Requirements

Dust explosion-proof distribution boxes are designed to contain internal explosions and prevent ignition of surrounding combustible dust. They typically feature cast aluminum, stainless steel, or GRP shells for mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, and durability in harsh environments . The structure often includes modular compartments for bus bars, outlets, and switches, allowing flexible configuration and safe operation . All components must be safe, reliable, easy to operate, and maintainable .

Electrical Component Standards

Electrical components inside the distribution box must comply with international standards such as IEC309-1, IEC309-2, DIN EN 60309, and national standards like GB11918-2001 and GB11919-2001 . High-quality components from certified manufacturers (e.g., ABB switches, Finikes terminals, Mennekes sockets) are recommended to ensure safety and reliability . Built-in miniature circuit breakers with overload, short-circuit, and leakage protection are essential.
