

Dust Prevention in Optical Cable Splicing

Clean Work Environment

Before splicing, establish a controlled, clean workspace. Use an enclosed splicing area or a clean bench to minimize airborne dust and debris. Ensure the work area is free from unnecessary materials, and implement housekeeping practices to prevent contamination from tools, clothing, or surfaces ().

Fiber Handling and Cleaning

- Wear powder-free gloves to prevent oils and dust from transferring to fiber ends ().
- Avoid touching fiber ends with fingers or allowing them to contact surfaces.
- Clean fiber ends using alcohol wipes or spectroscopic-grade methanol before splicing ().
- Use lens paper or lint-free wipes for cleaning optical surfaces and connectors.
- Inspect fiber ends with a fiber microscope or eye-loupe to ensure no dust or debris remains ().

Equipment Maintenance

- Regularly clean the fusion splicer's V-groove, electrodes, and objective lens to prevent dust accumulation ().
- Use filtered compressed air or canned air to remove dust from splicing equipment...
