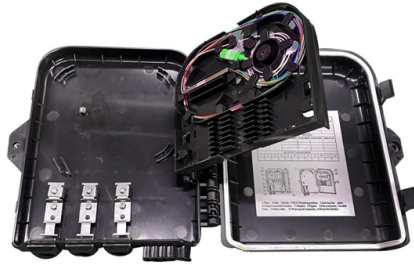


Electric fuse in the distribution box



Article Overview

An electric fuse in a distribution box is a safety device that protects circuits by interrupting power when current exceeds safe levels.

Purpose of a Fuse

A fuse is a critical component in a distribution box, designed to protect wiring and appliances from overloads or short circuits. It contains a metal strip that melts when the current exceeds a specified limit, breaking the circuit and stopping the flow of electricity. This prevents potential damage to electrical devices and reduces the risk of fire hazards in the home or building .

How Fuses Work

When normal current flows, the metal strip inside the fuse remains intact. If an overcurrent occurs due to a fault or excessive load, the strip heats up and melts, effectively cutting off power to the affected circuit. This action is immediate, ensuring that the rest of the electrical system remains safe .

Types of Fuses

- Cartridge Fuses: Cylindrical, often made of glass or ceramic, commonly found in older homes. The metal strip inside can be visually inspected to see if it is broken .
- Glass Fuses: Similar to cartridge fuses but with a clear glass body for easy inspection. A broken filament or discoloration indicates a blown fuse . Although fuses are still used in some older installations, modern distribution boxes often use circuit...
