

Elevation of cable trays



Article Overview

Cable tray elevation is the vertical positioning of the tray, typically measured from the bottom, center, or top of the tray, and must ensure proper clearance, support, and compliance with installation standards.

Determining Cable Tray Elevation

Cable tray elevation can be defined in three main ways: Top of Pipe (ToP), Center of Pipe (CoP), and Bottom of Pipe (BoP). For practical purposes, the elevation is often referenced from the bottom of the tray, which simplifies calculations and ensures accurate placement in Plant3D or other CAD systems. The tray height should be considered when annotating elevations to avoid errors in length calculations or center-of-gravity assumptions.

Installation Guidelines

According to NEC Article 392, cable trays must maintain adequate vertical clearance for installation and maintenance, typically at least 12 inches above the tray. Trays should not be installed in hoistways or enclosed spaces and must remain accessible. Proper elevation ensures that cables can be pulled without exceeding their minimum bend radius and prevents mechanical damage.

Offset and Elevation Changes

When a cable tray must change elevation to clear obstacles, the vertical rise and horizontal run form a right triangle, with the tray's diagonal as the hypotenuse. Co...
