Fiber optic communication transmits information as pulses of light through thin glass or plastic fibers, enabling high-speed, long-distance, and interference-free data transfer.

How Fiber Optic Communication Works

Fiber optic communication uses light pulses as a carrier of information, which are transmitted through an optical fiber. The fiber consists of a core and a cladding layer. The core, made of glass or plastic, carries the light, while the cladding has a lower refractive index, causing light to be trapped within the core through total internal reflection. This allows light to travel long distances with minimal signal loss . The light is modulated to encode information such as voice, video, or data .

Components of a Fiber Optic System

- **Transmitter:** Converts electrical signals into light signals using a laser or LED .
- **Optical Fiber:** The medium that guides light from the transmitter to the receiver, available in single-mode and multimode types .
- **Receiver:** Converts the light signals back into electrical signals for processing.
- **Repeaters/Amplifiers:** Used in long-distance communication to boost signal strength and maintain data integrity .

Advantages of Fiber Optics

- **High Bandwidth:** Can carry large amounts of data at very high speeds .
- **Long Distance Transmission:** Minimal signal loss allows communication over tens...
