

Fiber Optic Channel Color Selection Standard



Article Overview

Fiber optic color selection follows the TIA-598-C standard, assigning specific colors to outer jackets, individual fibers, and connectors to ensure accurate identification and prevent installation errors.

Outer Jacket Color Requirements

The outer jacket color is the first visual indicator of fiber type and mode:

- Single-mode fibers (OS1/OS2): Yellow jacket
 - Multimode fibers:
 - OM1/OM2: Orange
 - OM3/OM4: Aqua
 - OM4 (sometimes high-performance variant): Violet
 - OM5: Lime green
- These colors allow technicians to quickly distinguish fiber types and prevent mismatched connections in high-density or mixed-mode environments .

Inner Fiber Color Sequence

Individual fibers within multi-fiber cables are color-coded using a 12-color repeating sequence for easy identification:

- Blue
- Orange
- Green...
