Fiber tail end inspection ensures optical fiber end faces are clean, defect-free, and compliant with industry standards to maintain optimal network performance.

Purpose of Fiber Tail End Inspection

Inspecting the tail end of a fiber is critical because contamination, scratches, or defects on fiber end faces can increase insertion loss, reduce return loss, and even damage connectors or equipment during mating or splicing. Proper inspection ensures that fibers are ready for fusion splicing, connector mating, or network deployment without compromising signal quality.

Key Inspection Standards

The IEC 61300-3-35 standard provides guidelines for visual inspection and cleanliness grading of fiber end faces. The standard defines:

- Zones of inspection: Zone A (core) and Zone B (cladding) are critical for signal transmission, while Zones C and D (adhesive and contact areas) are less critical.
- Defect classification: Scratches (permanent linear features) and defects (pits, chips, embedded or loose debris).
- Pass/Fail criteria: Automated inspection tools can grade end faces based on defect size and location, reducing human subjectivity. The latest 2022 edition simplifies inspection by focusing on core and cladding zones and recommending removal of loose particles in contact areas before evaluating critical zones
