

Fiber optic cable core location

The core of a fiber optic cable is located at the very center of the cable, surrounded by cladding and protective layers, and serves as the pathway for light signals.

Core Placement and Structure

The core is the innermost part of a fiber optic cable, typically made of ultra-pure glass (silicon dioxide) or, in some cases, specialized plastic. It runs continuously along the length of the fiber, forming a cylindrical channel through which light signals travel. The core is surrounded by a layer called the cladding, which has a slightly lower refractive index than the core. This difference in refractive index ensures that light remains confined within the core through total internal reflection.

Core Dimensions

The diameter of the core varies depending on the fiber type:

- Single-mode fiber: Core diameter is about 8-10 micrometers, typically 9 microns, allowing light to travel in a single path for long-distance transmission.
- Multimode fiber: Core diameter ranges from 50 to 62.5 micrometers, permitting multiple light paths simultaneously, suitable for shorter distances like data centers or building networks. The notation "9/125" or "50/125" refers to core diameter over cladding diameter, measured in microns.
