

Fiber optic cable entering the vertical shaft cable tray



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables entering a vertical shaft cable tray must be supported, clamped at intervals, and installed according to NEC and TIA standards to manage tensile load and prevent damage.

Installation Overview

Fiber optic cables in vertical shafts are typically installed in cable trays or raceways, which provide a safe and efficient pathway for the cable while allowing easy access for maintenance and future expansion . Cable trays in vertical risers are not fully enclosed, so cables must be protected from sharp edges, projections, and environmental factors .

Tensile Load Considerations

In vertical installations, the weight of the cable creates a tensile load that can limit the maximum vertical rise. The cable's long-term tensile rating must not be exceeded. For example, a distribution-style fiber optic cable weighing 36 lbs/1000 ft with a long-term tensile load of 220 lbs can theoretically be installed vertically for approximately 6,100 feet ($220 \div 36 \times 1000$) . Exceeding this load can damage the cable or affect optical performance.
