Reserved fiber refers to unused or spare optical fibers within a fiber-optic cable that are set aside for future expansion, redundancy, or maintenance.

What Reserved Fiber Means

In fiber-optic networks, cables often contain more fibers than are immediately needed. These extra fibers, known as reserved or spare fibers, are intentionally left unused during initial deployment. They provide flexibility for future network growth, allowing additional connections without the need to install new cables, which can be costly and disruptive (Corning) .

Purpose of Reserved Fibers

- Future Expansion: Reserved fibers allow network operators to add new services or connect additional buildings without laying new cables (Wikipedia) .
- Redundancy and Reliability: Spare fibers can be activated if an active fiber fails, ensuring minimal downtime and maintaining network reliability (FOA) .
- Maintenance and Upgrades: Reserved fibers facilitate testing, rerouting, or upgrading the network without interrupting existing services (Belden) .
