What is Fiber Optic Communication?

Fiber optic communication is a method of transmitting information from one place to another by sending pulses of light through optical fibers. These fibers are made of glass or plastic and are designed to carry light signals over long distances with minimal loss. The light acts as a carrier wave that is modulated to convey information, making fiber optics a preferred choice for telecommunications, internet, and cable television signals .

Components of Fiber Optic Communication

- **Optical Fiber:** The core component, consisting of a central core surrounded by cladding. The core is where the light travels, while the cladding reflects the light back into the core, allowing it to travel long distances through total internal reflection .
- **Transmitter:** Converts electrical signals into optical signals. Common light sources include light-emitting diodes (LEDs) and laser diodes. LEDs produce incoherent light, while laser diodes produce coherent light, which is more efficient for long-distance communication .
- **Receiver:** Converts the optical signals back into electrical signals. It typically includes a photodetector that captures the light and converts it into an electrical current .
- **Optical Amplifiers:** Used to boost the signal strength over long distances, compen...
