Fiber optic communication is inherently a wired technology that transmits data as pulses of light through physical glass or plastic fibers.

Fiber optic communication relies on a physical network of thin glass or plastic strands that carry information in the form of light pulses, making it a wired system rather than wireless . Each fiber is hair-thin and bundled into cables, with light signals bouncing along the core through total internal reflection, allowing data to travel long distances with minimal loss . At the sending end, electrical signals are converted into light by lasers or LEDs, and at the receiving end, photodetectors convert the light back into electrical signals .

Components and Structure

- Core: The central part of the fiber that transmits light.
- Cladding: Surrounds the core and reflects light back into it, maintaining signal integrity.
- Buffer Coating: Protects the fiber from physical damage . This structure ensures high bandwidth, long-distance transmission, and immunity to electromagnetic interf...
