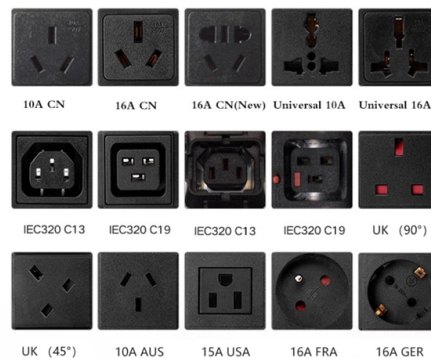


Fiber optic tube connection to optical cable

Preparing the Optical Cable

Before connecting a fiber optic tube, the optical cable must be properly prepared:

- **Sheath Removal:** Remove the outer jacket carefully without exceeding the cable's minimum bend radius to avoid fiber breakage.
- **Buffer Tube Access:** For loose tube cables, identify the buffer tube reversal point to safely unwind the fibers. Access a sufficient length of the cable core (typically around 2 meters) for proper handling
